News From Our Community!

This week we continued to work on our informational writing. Students worked to write the first chapter of their informational book. Students included a topic sentence, supporting details, concluding sentence and of course a teaching picture!

This week during reading we continued to investigate how readers use inferring to better understand text. We learned that readers infer to make predictions and to determine the big idea of text. We read the story The Royal Bee and used information from the text to infer how the story would end. We also read poems by Georgia Heard and used clues from the text, as well as our schema, to infer the main topic of the poems.

This week we also continued to read and learn about the life of

Martin Luther King Jr. We talked about his dreams for our country and had a chance to share our own dreams and hopes for the future.

During science we continued our study of matter. In this week’s lesson students began to understand two principles that can be related to atoms: that smaller things make up bigger things and that the organization of parts may change the function or appearance.

During math we started a new unit of study on modeling two-digit addition. Students will be working to add two digit numbers with and without regrouping. A summary of your child’s progress during our last unit will come home soon!
